
# **Drury Family Epic Summer Holiday**

This afternoon we went to the ruins in Polonnaruwa. Lots of Buddhist and Hindu Temples. And lots of guys trying to sell us tat








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June 30, 2013, 6 p.m.

Went to a cultural dance show with fire eating and walking on hot coals, it was quite good.










July 2, 2013, 6:30 p.m.






July 5, 2013, 8:54 p.m.






July 7, 2013, 9:43 p.m.






July 14, 2013, noon

Arrived at Tioman Island, on a tiny plane (48 seater). It looks stunning (the island, not the plane, the plane looks like an air fix kit)










July 19, 2013, 4:30 p.m.






July 26, 2013, 9 a.m.
